WHEREAS, without these public servants at every level, continuity would be impossible in a democracy that regularly changes its leaders and elected officials.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, TERRY M. BELLAMY, Mayor of the City of Asheville, do hereby proclaim that May 1-7, 2011 is
