

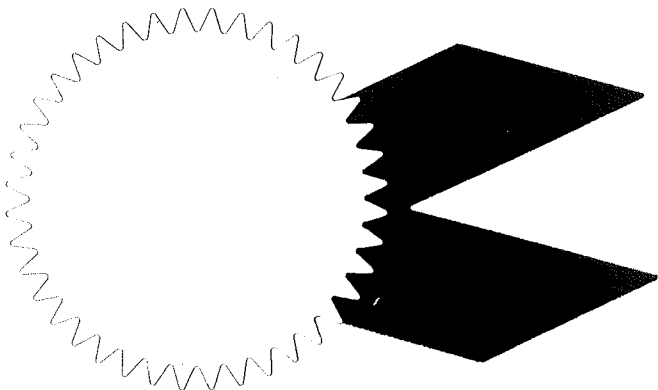
MAYORAL PROCLAMATION


- WHEREAS,** residents of Madison are served every single day by the public servants who work for the City of Madison. These unsung heroes do the work that keeps our city working; and
