PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, Hoosiers are served every single day by public servants at the federal, state, county and city levels; and
- WHEREAS, many public servants, including military personnel, police officers, firefighters, healthcare professionals risk their lives each day for the sake of the people they serve; and

Day in and day out they provide the diverse services the American people ask of their government with efficiency and integrity; and
